

2021 Return-to-Play

Spectator Procedures

- Arrive on-site approximately 5 minutes before the start of programming. And depart within 5 minutes of completion.
- Upon arrival, wear a mask, sanitize hands and verbally complete the Wellness Pre-Participation Screening Form to the trainer/Health and Safety Manager, they will record your name, contact and results on the form.
- Please ensure that you are following the mandated physical distancing guidelines.
- If a spectator arrives at the facility late, proceed to the registration area to complete the Wellness Pre-Participation Screening Form.
- 3 spectators per player is allowed to attend as our capacity for the field is 100.
- Every person in attendance is expected to follow the rules provided by North Perth
 Outlaws Committee, HPPH, and the OLA at all times to ensure the safety of players,
 facility staff, spectators and the North Perth Outlaws Lacrosse programme. Disregard of
 rules for safety will result in:
- 1st offence- a polite reminder
- 2nd offence- any person(s) will be asked to leave the facility
- If disregard of the safety rules continues game suspension or even expulsion can occur.

Note:

- You will be required to wear a face mask for the duration of your tenure on-site.
- If you are attending more than one session, please check in again to ensure you are recorded as attending both sessions.
- We ask that all spectators place close attention to the game and watch for balls leaving the playing area
- We must all remember that this is lacrosse program is about the player safety and enjoyment first and foremost
